

Job Title: Pole Auditor
Location: Longview, Texas
Department: Field Operations
Reports To: Regional Plant Manager

Job Summary:

The primary responsibility of this position is to locate poles and audit the position of the company's plant as it relates to the NESC standards. The Pole Auditor will file reports of his/her findings with the Regional Plant Manager and Vice President and see that any violations discovered during the audit are resolved in a timely manner. This position is supervised by the Regional Plant Manager.

Job Duties:

1. Locating poles
2. Identifying, measuring, and documenting the company's pole attachments
3. When violations are found, create a plan to correct the violation and provide plan to Regional Plant Manager to resolve issues.
4. Recording and preserving excellent and clear records of audit findings and repairs
5. Building and maintaining a working relationship with pole owners and other utilities sharing the usable space
6. Detecting, recording and repairing signal leakage issues
7. Other job duties as requested

Qualifications:

- High School Diploma or GED
- The ability to read and understand signal level meter
- Computer Proficiency with Microsoft Word and Excel software
- Skilled in reading and interpreting engineering drawings related to utility and cable system design
- Working knowledge of the NESC Pole Attachment guidelines
- Basic knowledge of GPS devices
- A clear understanding of coax cable operation and design
- Must meet the requirements of an Installer-Data

Language Skills:

Ability to read and comprehend simple instructions, short correspondence, and memos. Ability to write simple correspondence. Ability to effectively present information in one-on-one and small group situations.

Work Environment:
